



# Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) WHAT IS IT?

An employer with 100 or more employees who report to work at a single site between 6 a.m. and 9 a.m. is affected by the Washington State Commute Trip Reduction law.



# WHO TAKES THE SURVEY?

Work at least 35 hours per week

Arrive at the worksite between 6 a.m. and 9 a.m.

Work 2 or more weekdays

Job is intended to last at least 12 continuous months

Fall of Odd Years – e.g. Fall 2019, Fall 2021, etc.

#### **BEST PRACTICIES:**

Allow at least 2 weeks to prepare for the survey **Do not survey** with a holiday during the window

\*Companies that observe Veteran's Day are **not eligible**for this survey window


# 4 WEEKS BEFORE PREPARE SURVEY TOOL (NOW)

## Recommended: Upload

- Upload excel file with employee emails – <u>template found here</u>
- Only uploaded emails can access survey ©
- Run a report on who has not taken survey and reach out to them and encourage their participation – boost that response rate!

### **Domain**

- All emails with @companyname.com domain have access
- Easy access and bulk administration ©
- No targeted communication reports available ☺







- Only available by request
- Additional administration needed burdensome <sup>(3)</sup>
- Good for retail and service industries ©
- Great for employees who have no computer access ©
- No targeted communications
- Translated surveys available ©



# COMMUNICATE TO LEADERSHIP

+/-Two weeks before survey:

## Communicate importance of survey to leadership

- 1. Work with C-Suite Executives to send email about survey to all staff
- 2. Work with Middle Management and Supervisors to communicate survey during team meetings
- 3. Let IT know if necessary
- 4. Use our boilerplate communications to get started



# WHAT MAKES THE SURVEY SUCCESSFUL?

## Response Rate

- 50% Response Rate accepted
- 70% Response Rate better data, 20% buffer
- Log into CTR Tool and check response rate at least 2 times per week – Monday and Wednesday

#### ETCs are KEY!

- Communicate early and often
- Share posters in common areas
- Post <u>intranet announcements</u> schedule them if you can!
- Work with middle management to communicate in team meetings
- Executive leadership should communicate survey importance

#### **TIPS AND TRICKS:**

Make sure you are here for the survey! The survey can't administer itself; its needs you!

Message from CEO or executive – even a follow up as the survey deadline approaches gives staff an extra nudge to participate.

<u>Incentives WORK!</u> Offer small gift cards, free coffee or treat, or swag.
