2019 CTR Surveys:

The Washington State Legislature's <u>Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) Law</u> requires employers to work with employees to reduce the number and length of drive-alone commute trips made to their worksite. Every two years, employees at CTR-affected work sites must complete a CTR survey which includes questions about how they commute.
